

CAMPING CHECKLIST

- Tent with screen
- Tent rain cover (thin, clear plastic)
- The rug in front of the tent
- Blue tarp for footing
- Small brush for cleaning
- Air mattress / Air pump
- Sleeping bag or warm blankets
- Pillow
- Folding chair (each person)
- Flashlight *and* Head flashlight
- Light for inside the tent
- Extra batteries
- Backpack (not too big)
- Backpack for child
- Hiking sticks
- Water bottles
- Water filters or treatment tablets
- Multi-tool
- Knife (adults only)
- Foldable shovel
- Gloves (for branch collection)
- Cap or hiking hat

- First Aid kit (bandages, Neosporin, anti-itch)
- Allergy medication / Pain relief / Tums
- Hand sanitizer / Antiseptic wipes
- Short-sleeve shirts
- Long-sleeve shirts
- Shorts
- Pants
- Socks
- Underwear
- Sleepwear
- Swimwear
- Hiking pants
- Hiking shoes (sneakers or boots)
- Wool socks (recommended for hiking)
- Jacket or Vest
- Rainwear
- Bag for dirty clothing

- Towel (for bath and swimming)
- Hand soap
- Personal toiletry items
- Towels (for “bath”)
- Brush / Comb
- Ear plugs (for better sleeping)
